

ADVISORY ON SCI EXAMINATIONS (ON-SITE)

(Updated on 24 December 2021)

With effect from 1 January 2022, unvaccinated individuals are unable to gain access into Suntec City Office Tower 2 to proceed to the SCI to take their examination (even if they produce their Acknowledgement of Examination Registration Email) unless they fall under the following:

Medically ineligible for vaccines under the National Vaccination Programme (NVP) and has a negative Antigen Rapid Test (ART) administered via a Pre-Event Test (PET) at an MOH-approved COVID-19 test provider 24 hours before the expected end of examination session. Suntec is still pending the details from the Authorities on this. **[via TraceTogether App]**

Negative Antigen Rapid Test (ART) administered via a Pre-Event Test (PET) at an MOH-approved COVID-19 test provider 24 hours before the expected end of examination session. **[Result uploaded via TraceTogether App]**

Vaccinated individuals or have recovered from COVID-19 within 270 (change to 180) days, can return to the workplace. From 1 January 2022, VDS exemption for non-vaccinated COVID-19 recovered persons will be reduced from 270 to 180 days. **[via TraceTogether App]**

For Antigen Rapid Test (ART) administered via a Pre-Event Test (PET) at an MOH-approved COVID-19 test provider:

The test has to be done prior (not during or not after) to their entry to the mall as access to the office. The test time of 24 hours must be able to cover them throughout the duration of the examination time that he or she is in the examination premises.
